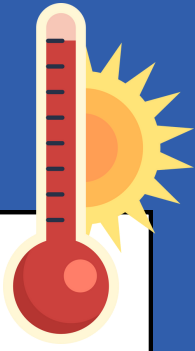


Weather Policy



Excursions

If the estimated maximum temperature forecast for the day is 36° or above most excursions will be cancelled. Parents will be informed through text message of the decision to cancel the excursion.

Exceptions may be made after a risk assessment has been completed and at the direction of the leadership team.

Outdoor Play

If the temperature at recess or lunch has exceeded 30°, the teacher on duty will determine if the hall or a classroom can be provided as an alternative area for students away from the heat.

If the temperature at recess or lunch has reached 36° (or below if deemed extreme due to hot winds) then there will be no outside play. Staff will follow the current duty roster. Students will be provided with play time in an allocated classroom or in the hall.

Parents are encouraged to supply spare clothes during the hot season in the event that students engage in water play.

Wet Weather Policy

In the case of wet weather, admin will decide whether yard play will be cancelled for the students and an announcement will then be made over the PA system before recess and/or lunch informing all staff of their decision. If outdoor play is cancelled, staff will follow the current duty roster in an allocated classroom.

Parents are encouraged to supply spare clothes during the wet season in the event that students play in the puddles at yard times.
